An exciting re-modelling and extension of two mews houses in a sensitive conservation area. The building is triangular to match the site boundaries and culminates in a circular design studio which in addition to providing an elevated place to work, with access to the roof, acts as a light-well to the interior of the house.



85 Swains Lane N6

Swains Lane was commissioned as a shell to be fitted out by the owners. Adjoining Highgate Cemetery, to the south are magnificent views over London, whilst to the north the older generation of the client family resided. For these reasons and due to poor soil foundations, the house was kept low, and for fun, it was decided to support the house on one central concrete pillar and to truss up the first floor as a cantilever.

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
